Officer note: condition 10 covers materials, however, with regards to the request for a condition relating to window details it is considered that such a condition fails to meet the six tests for example when considering whether a particular condition is necessary, LPA should ask themselves whether planning permission would be refused if a condition were not imposed – in this instance the absence of such a condition would not be sufficient to warrant a refusal.
