

Summary of Minimum Local Standards for Playing Pitches and Other Types of Open Space

The following table demonstrates the local standards that have been created for Craven District Council to allow the examination of provision in relation to surplus and deficiency.

These should be taken into consideration when receiving a planning application on any of the land types listed and when development occurs which requires the creation of open space.
