DECEMBER 2011

The North Yorkshire Strategic Housing Market Assessment (SHMA) was approved by the Local Government North Yorkshire & York Housing Board at its meeting on the 12th December 2011. The report is a study of local housing markets across North Yorkshire, and includes detailed information on local housing need in Craven. Parish Profiles - Draft Parish Profiles have been prepared for the villages within Craven (outside the Yorkshire Dales National Park) which have a population of more than 1000. The intention is to provide a snapshot of each profiled parish in terms of its social, economic, environmental and transportation characteristics. The completed profiles will help the council to produce a Development Plan that responds to the distinct nature of each profiled parish and to address important issues in those parishes.

AUGUST 2011 Parish Profiling

The Planning Policy Team are creating Parish Profiles for the larger towns and villages in the District (those with more than 1000 inhabitants). The Profiles built up with help from Town and Parish Councils and will provide a snapshot of the Parish in terms of its social, economic, environmental and transportation characteristics. The Planning Policy Team attended Town and Parish Council meetings over the summer to gather local information and

identify the assets and facilities of each parish, the aspects which should be preserved and the areas which are considered to be in need of improvement. The finished profiles will be used as the new Local Development Plan is prepared to help produce a plan which responds to the distinct nature of each of the Parishes within the Craven District (outside the YDNP) and addresses the issues which are important to each of these individual Parishes. The Profile could also be used by local communities in producing Neighbourhood Plans in order that the matters of importance in each Parish can be addressed.
