



Planning Policy Team Work Programme

January – June 2013

This is an approximate timetable and programme of work to take us to the next phase of informal engagement on the new local plan. Whilst it is based on reasonable assumptions and estimates, it may yet be subject to revision, in response to changing or unpredictable circumstances. Notwithstanding these caveats, the Planning Policy Team is committed to making good progress on the new local plan and intends that the following should be helpful to all stakeholders.

January – Mid February

Site Checklists: Carry out Part Two checks on all SHLAA sites that have passed through Part One.

Mid February – Mid April

Site Checklists: Where necessary, seek additional information from consultees and landowners/developers, in order to complete Part Two checks.

Infrastructure: Identify strategic infrastructure requirements using checklist information obtained from consultees and landowners/developers.

Policies: Prepare draft spatial strategy and housing policies.

Economy: Prepare an Economic Development Discussion Paper.

Sustainability Appraisal: Carry out an initial SA of the emerging spatial strategy, housing figure, policies and allocations.

Mid April – Mid May

Preparation: Make final preparations for the forthcoming informal engagement.

Mid May – Mid June

Informal Engagement: Engage with the full range of stakeholders to discuss the emerging spatial strategy, housing figure, policies, allocations and strategic infrastructure requirements; and to discuss local economic development and the initial SA.

Craven Spatial Planning Sub-Committee

Late February: Hold a meeting to discuss and agree the method(s) of engagement.

Late March/ early April: Hold a meeting to discuss and agree draft policies for engagement.

Late April: Hold a meeting to discuss and agree draft housing allocations for engagement; and strategic economic development sites, for inclusion in the Economic Development Discussion Paper.

Alternatives: The first meeting could be at the beginning of March; the second and third meetings could be combined into a single meeting to be held in late April.

Specific dates and times for sub-committee meetings will be confirmed in due course.
