

Minutes of the Grassington Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 24th November 2016

- 1. To receive apologies for absence- Cllr Charlton, Cllr Brooksbank
- 2. To receive and declarations of interest or applications for dispensations under the Council's Code of Conduct- Cllr Darwin; items 8, 10.3 and 10.4
- 3. To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 27th October 2016 as a true and fair record-Minutes of this meeting were approved.

4. Financial Matters

4.1 The following accounts were approved for payment

- 4.2 The Council has received a donation for a commemorative bench. It was agreed that a plaque would be purchased and affixed to the bench in front of the Town Hall. The clerk will write to the donor expressing thanks.
- 4.3 Future financial planning and 2017/18 budget

The Council needs to set a budget for 2017/18 and also to establish longer-term financial planning. Upon the return of the RFO the clerk will be advised of the date for a formal meeting of the Finance sub-committee. This meeting is to take place in December to enable recommendations to be put to the full Council on 5 January 2017.

6. Property Matters

- 6.1Town Hall lease negotiations
 - Cllr Rooze will approach a local architect about the costs of a report on possible internal alterations
 - -a pre-meeting of the Council will take place in January ahead of the next meeting with trustees.
- 6.2 The need for a roof survey was agreed; the Clerk will follow up.and was authorised to make an appointment subject to a maximum cost of £500.00.
 - 6.3 Purchase of paint for remarking Wood Lane car park was approved

- 6.4 The Council agreed to accept the tender from Wetpour Ltd to repair the surface under the swings at a cost of £1,389.60 including VAT.
- 6.5 The Playing Fields Assn is to be thanked for their offer of financial help. They will be asked to accept Cllrs Smith and Kendall as Council members.

- 7.3 A pothole between Sigg Barn and Wood Lane will be reported.

8. Planning Applications

- 8.1 C/33/379A Conversion of barn on Garrs End Lane to holiday cottage (Cllr Darwin left the meeting for this item)-fully supported
- 8.2 C/33/109B 3 Station Road-Construction of two houses on site of former garage-seen to be a major improvement to a prominent village centre site.

- 10.1 It was agreed to introduce a table of follow-up actions.
- 10.2 Grassington BID-it was noted that the Grassington Bid initiative has been abandoned.

The organisers of various events in the village will continue to hold joint meetings .

- 10.3 Broken Fence posts on footpath to Gaistrills-to be reported to YDNPA
- 10.4 Wall at Ratcliffe Corner, The was deemed unsafe and Ratcliffe corner to be closed off. A letter will be written to the adjacent landowner.
- 10.5 Dates of future meetings was agreed; 5th January 2017, 2nd February 2017, 2nd March 2017, 30th March 2017
- 10.6 Walking Festival Cllr Rooze had not received sufficient support for this proposed event. Cllrs were given until 9th December to come up with initiatives to support this; otherwise it will be cancelled at that time.
