COMMUNITY GRANTS FUND - APPLICATIONS

The Partnerships Officer submitted a report presenting four applications for grant assistance under the Council's Community Grants Scheme. Each application had been assessed and scored using the criteria agreed by Policy Committee on 17th June 2014. The budgetary provision available for allocation in 2015/16, including £2,055.55 carried forward from 2014/15 amounted to £23,614.55. The balance currently available amounted to £16,829.55.

In summary, the applications presented were as follows:

- (i) Skipton Music Festival : Festival 2016 – Project cost £6,000; amount requested £250.
- (ii) Friends of Embsay Wall Memorial : Generic Bronze Plaque for the War Memorial – Project cost £995; amount requested £497.50.
- (iii) Settle Town Council : Cycle Friendly Settle – Project cost £1,250; amount requested £312.50.
- (iv) Sutton-in-Craven Community Centre : Improved Seating – Project cost £1,320; amount requested £660.

Copies of the appraisal forms for each application had been circulated with the Partnership Officer's report.

Resolved – That decisions on the above applications for funding now submitted under the Community Grants Scheme are made as follows:-

- a. Skipton Music Festival – Grant awarded in the sum of £250 or 10% whichever is the lesser amount, subject to receipt of at least four letters of support from local community groups and the Town Council, and also confirmation that all competition classes are open to people of all beliefs and none.
- b. Friends of Embsay War Memorial – Consideration deferred pending provision of clear evidence that the project is supported by the local community.
- c. Settle Town Council – Grant awarded in the sum of £312.50 or 25% whichever is the lesser amount.

- d. Sutton-in-Craven Community Centre – Grant awarded in the sum of £660 or 50% whichever is the lesser amount, subject to the applicant providing two quotes for the chairs and at least four letters of support from local groups showing that they support the project
