# **CONFIRMATION OF THE COUNCIL TAX BASE - 2015/16**



Report of the Corporate Head of Business Support

Ward(s) affected: All

1. Purpose of Report – To approve the Council Tax Base for the 2015/16 financial year.

#### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1 That in accordance with the Local Authorities (Calculation of Tax Base) Regulations 1992 (as amended) the amount calculated by Craven District Council as its tax base for the whole of the area for 2015/16 financial year is set at 21366.82
- 2.2 That in accordance with the Local Authorities (Calculation of Tax Base) Regulations 1992 (as amended) the amount calculated by Craven District Council as the tax base for each of its Parishes for the 2015/16 financial year is that as set out in Appendix A to this report.

## 3. Report

- 3.1 Council Tax Base figures are calculated annually in accordance with the Local Government Finance Act 1992 (as amended) and relevant regulations and are used by each billing and major precepting authority in the calculation of the basic amounts of Council Tax. The figures must be notified to all major precepting authorities (e.g. North Yorkshire County Council, levying bodies, and parishes) on request before 31<sup>st</sup> January 2015.
- 3.2 The Council Tax Base is calculated as the sum of the relevant amounts for each valuation band multiplied by the billing authority's estimated collection rate for the year. For information, comparative tax bases for the current and previous financial years and the number of properties in the Craven District are shown below.

<sup>\*</sup>The final adjusted tax base reflects an adjustment for council tax support and an estimated collection rate of 98.25%.

3.3 There are due to be two parish boundary changes, effective from April 2015, resulting in properties moving from Thornton–in-Craven to Elslack.

3.4 The formula used to calculate the tax base has been updated to take account of both the technical changes to council tax discounts and exemptions, and the change from council tax benefit to local council tax reduction schemes (council tax support). The tax base recommended in this report reflects the decisions made at Full Council on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2012 to abolish the second home discount and to amend the exempt classes A and C.

### 4. <u>Implications</u>

- 4.1 **Financial Implications** For every £1 of Council Tax levied the tax base, as proposed, will enable the Authority to meet £21,366.82 of expenditure in 2015/16 compared with £21,179.96 in the current financial year.
- 4.2 **Legal Implications** None arising directly from this report. Collection of Council Tax is a statutory function of the local authority and reporting of the Tax base is a necessary stage in the process.
- 4.3 **Contribution to Corporate Priorities** None arising directly from this report.
