... 25 year old Mike has lived in the parish of Marrick all his life. He is currently living with his parents and two siblings in a small terraced cottage.

Mike works for a local farmer, earning £262 per week. He would like his own place but, due to high house prices and rents in the popular parish of Marrick, he is unable to afford to move out.

Mike is captain of the local cricket and football teams and volunteers for the Round Table.

He has £2,000 in savings.



Is this you?

Mike's story is real and his situation is commonplace within rural communities.

You see Mike in the village shop and socialise with him in the pub, yet without affordable housing, Mike is one of the many people who form part of our rural communities but who have to move away to a town or city.

But it does not have to be like this...





What can Mike do to stay local?

- Make sure he is registered on the North Yorkshire HomeChoice at their local council.
- Approach Parish Councillors they may know of properties in the village.
- Speak to his local Ward Councillor about new affordable housing in the local area or parish.
- Speak to friends who may be in the same position - affordable housing schemes need support!
- Contact his Rural Housing Enabler for advice on staying local.
