The Wilson's Story...







Helping the Wilson Family...

... James and Paula Wilson lived in Gargrave until they married and started a family.

They had to leave the village as they could not afford to buy or rent a family home.

They have lived in Skipton for 13 years with their children, Mark (10) and Rachel (2) and rent a three bedroom terrace for £750 per month.

Mr Wlison works at Townson Tractors in Hellifield but his wife cannot work full time due to arthritis which means she has to use a wheelchair. The house in Skipton however is not suitable for wheelchair use.

When work started on a small development of accessible, affordable homes for local people in Gargrave. The Wilsons were not sure they would qualify as they both worked.

They contacted the local Rural Housing Enabler who told them about affordable home ownership and gave them advice on how to register with 'HomeChoice'.

The Wlisons learnt that they could part buy a home with a housing association. After looking at their financial situation, the housing association advised that they could afford a 35% share. The association would own the remaining 65% share.

They were offered a mortgage and made an offer on the property through 'Home Choice'.





This is their story, what's yours?

This was the solution for the Wilson Family and they are now living back in Gargrave, surrounded by family and friends, providing a support network for the family.
