CONDITIONS FOR THE LICENSING OF MEMORIAL MASONS TO WORK IN THE COUNCIL'S CEMETERIES AND CREMATORIUM

1. All work must be carried out in accordance with the National Association of Memorial Masons (NAMM) Recommended Code of Working Practice (current edition), a copy of which you must have.
2. All work must comply with the Council's Rules and Regulations Governing Memorials a revised copy of which, together with the relevant diagrams, is attached. **(Please ensure that you fully read and understand this document before signing the questionnaire and applying for registration).**
3. You must be licensed by the Council and have signed the Declaration on the License Application Form and completed the Questionnaire before you will be permitted to carry out work in the Council's Cemeteries and Crematorium.
4. Each license is valid for one year from the date that the application form is signed as approved by an authorised Officer of the Council.

Under no circumstances is any licensed Memorial Mason entitled to hold himself out as "approved" or "recommended" by the Council. All advertising and promotional literature must simply state that the said Mason is "licensed" or "registered" to carry out work on the Council's property.
