



MOORINGS CLOSED MONDAY 25TH NOVEMBER TO FRIDAY 21ST DECEMBER 2019.

Due to improvement works being carried out on the Canal towpath mooring restrictions will be in place as indicated for areas shown on plan in **RED**. The dates shown are worst case but the contractor may be able to release areas for mooring as the work progresses. Subject to availability, pleasure craft may moor at other locations within Skipton subject to local restrictions. Craven District Council apologises for any inconvenience caused to boat owners wishing to use the moorings between Gawflat Bridge and Brewery Bridge. Please ensure that you vacate the indicated sections of towpath by 10pm the night before the indicated closure dates.
