Decision including:	The requirement in the Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Policy 2018 that (1) vehicles are tested at the Council's approved garage and (2) only MOT certificates issued by the approved garage will be accepted, is suspended for a period of three months from the date of this decision
(a) details:	The Council's approved garage, Midgley Motor Cars, notified the Council on the 1 st April 2020 that vehicle testing was being suspended with immediate effect.
(b) reasons:	As taxis across the District are being used to transport key workers and also the children of key workers (complying with social distancing requirements) urgent temporary arrangements need to be put in place to ensure that suitable vehicles continue to be licensed whilst ensuring measures to protect public safety are maintained.
(c) alternatives considered and rejected:	The option of using the Council's own facilities at Engine Shed Lane Depot were considered but this option was discounted due to the overriding priority to ensure Waste Management's vehicles are kept on the road and waste collections continue as normal for as long as possible during the coronavirus pandemic.
